
Scholarship Application

Academic Scholarship Process (Awarded in the Fall Only):

- **Academic Scholarships Available:** Academic Higher Achiever Scholarship, Presidential Scholarship, Building Bridges Grant, Academic Work Scholarship, Academic Out of State Tuition Waiver Scholarship, and Access and Diversity Grant
- **Application Process:** Must be admitted to TSU; Complete the enclosed scholarship application by March 31st and have a completed FAFSA application on file (www.fafsa.gov), our School code is 003522.
- **Notification:** Recipients will receive a scholarship award letter and contract at the email address listed on the application. Awards may be made as applications are received until all funding has been exhausted. Scholarship awards are dependent upon available funding. **Consequently, meeting the minimum requirements for a scholarship does not guarantee scholarship selection.** Funding for all of the above scholarships is limited.
- **Academic Higher Achiever Scholarship**
 - **Amount:** Tuition and Room & Board for four year period
 - **Criteria:** State of Tennessee high school graduate with a 3.0 High School GPA Un-weighted **and** 21 ACT or 980 SAT (Verbal and Math) and no prior college attendance
- **Presidential Scholarship**
 - **Amount:** Tuition and Room & Board for four year period
 - **Criteria:** high school graduate with a 3.5 High School GPA Un-weighted **and** 25 ACT or 1130 SAT (Verbal and Math) and no prior college attendance
- **Building Bridges Grant**
 - **Amount:** Tuition and Room & Board for four year period
 - **Criteria:** State of Tennessee high school graduate with a 2.5 High School GPA Un-weighted **and** 19 ACT or 900 SAT (Verbal and Math); and no prior college attendance; Must also be from one of the following Tennessee counties: Cheatham, Davidson, Dickson, Robertson, Rutherford, Shelby, Sumner, Warren, Williamson, or Wilson
- **Academic Work Scholarship**
 - **Amount:** Tuition for four year period and \$150.00 per semester for books
 - **Criteria:** State of Tennessee high school graduate with a 2.9 High School GPA Un-weighted **and** 19 ACT or 900 SAT (Verbal and Math) and no prior college attendance
 - **Additional requirements:** If awarded, student must work on campus 75 hours per semester;
- **Academic Out of State Tuition Waiver Scholarship**
 - **Amount:** Cost of Out of State Tuition for four year period
 - **Criteria:** Out of state high school graduate 3.0 High School GPA Un-weighted **and** 21 ACT or 980 SAT (Verbal and Math) and no prior college attendance
- **Access and Diversity Grant**
 - **Amount:** Tuition, awarded on a semester basis. Awards may vary;
 - **Criteria:** 2.5 High School GPA Un-weighted **and** 19 ACT or 900 SAT (Verbal and Math) for first time freshmen; or 3.0 for Transfer and continuing students; and Must also meet one of the following requirements: FAFSA expected contribution of \$4,000 or less; or pursuing a degree in a STEM discipline such as engineering, math, biology, nursing, etc.
